



## STRIKER Hotting Up In The Pilbara

On the back of a successful supply and installation of a 3,000,000 tonne per annum iron ore crushing and screening plant in the Central Pilbara during 2010, STRIKER have just secured a contract for a major plant expansion at the same site ramping up capacity to 5,000,000 tonnes per year.

The publicly listed client has made major in roads into the WA mining industry in recent years and STRIKER remains their preferred source of crushing, screening and materials handling equipment.

The original plant was commissioned to produce a minus 10mm hematite DSO comprising of a primary feeder unit, secondary and tertiary cone crushers feeding onto triple deck screens, then being sampled before finally being stockpiled utilizing radial conveyors.

The plant upgrade due for installation in the second quarter of 2012 will see the introduction of STRIKER JM1310 primary jaw crusher weighing in at 100 tonne to handle any oversize presented in the feed material from the surface miner, additional STRIKER conveyors, feed bins and electrical upgrades, along with a newly released STRIKER 32m long radial stacker to handle the increased capacity of the plant.

Project Manager in charge of the upgrade for STRIKER, Jim Hamill comments, "during an evaluation process the client hired from STRIKERS extensive hire fleet, a STRIKER JM1310 jaw crusher, another crusher from an Irish based manufacturer and finally another crusher of European origin. What better way for the client to ensure they were making an informed decision than to test 3 different crushers in their site and all in exactly the same application.

It became apparent quite early in the evaluation process that neither of the imported machines could perform to the level of the STRIKER, in fact reports from site indicate that the foreign machines were only capable of processing around 600 tph with regular stoppages whereas the STRIKER JM1310 consistently produced 1000 tph. It is quite obvious that the light weight imported machines are ideally suited to concrete recycling in capital cities. But when dealing with the extreme conditions encountered on mine sites in Australia nothing can perform as well as a STRIKER plant.

A paramount design feature of the STRIKER plants is our ability to add extra capacity whether it be primary, secondary or tertiary to any of our plants without the need for expensive shut downs or relocations. To double this plants capacity will take no longer than a few weeks from STRIKERS arrival on site, and with iron ore sales at high prices our client could not be happier with the speed in which this project can be delivered".

STRIKER and its customers look forward to many more years of Ken and take this opportunity to thank him for all his efforts of the past, present and future.

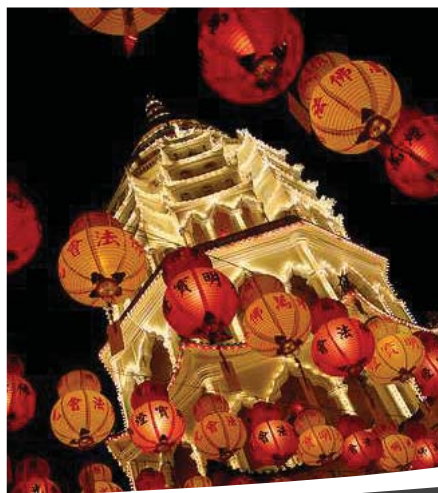
## Year Of The Dragon

## STRIKER goes 5.777 quickest Top Doorslammer pass in Australia



John Zappia and the STRIKER owned Top Doorslammer, nick named "The Crusher" presented for the Fuchs Nationals - Round 1 of the ANDRA Pro Series Top Doorslammer 2011/2012 Series - and let everyone know why STRIKER is the Australian National Record Holder by recording the first "five seven" in competition, and claimed top qualifier position.

First qualifier for Zappia saw him launch right, shake and head for the wall. "I took a chance, hit second gear and turned the wheel expecting it to turn, but the front wheels may have been off the ground and I glanced the wall, and missed my first chance" said an upbeat Zappia.

"What happened next was quite amazing. A good launch off the line that headed right a little caused me to pedal and correct, then it pulled so strongly through all the gears, but to be honest when the track officials told me I had run a 5.777 @ 250.74mph I was stunned. I had actually short shifted in second gear, so to run that time - Australia's quickest pass in a Doorslammer - and top qualify in the field was a highlight of the meeting".

The team will be back in Perth for Round Three of the ANDRA Top Doorslammer Championship at the Western Nationals on 3-4th March 2012 at the Perth Motorplex, where Zap will attempt to rein in Peter Kapiris who leads the series with 279.5 points, and stop fellow West Australian Robin Judd who trails Zap (209.5 points) on 187.5 points.
